Re: Agreement with Boone County Historical Society to use aviation collection

Executive Summary

An agreement with Boone County Historical Society needs approval to use its aviation collection, which was donated to the organization by local resident Nancy Badger. The collection will be featured in the new terminal at the Columbia Regional Airport.

Discussion

Boone County Historical Society (BCHS) has made its Woods-Badger Aviation Collection available for use in the new terminal at Columbia Regional Airport. The collection was donated to BCBS by Columbia resident Nancy Badger, whose family operated Columbia Flying Service from the mid-1940s to 1971 at the original Columbia Municipal Airport. An agreement between City of Columbia and BCBS needs approval in order to use the collection in the new terminal. The BCBS board of directors reviewed and approved the agreement at its May 27, 2020 meeting

The agreement grants the City permission to exhibit and/or make images of items from the collection for display in the new terminal. The Design/Build company for the terminal plans to incorporate elements of the collection into the building design.
