Re: Amending Chapter 14 of the City Code Relating to Parking Prohibited.

Executive Summary

Staff is proposing to amend Section 14-324 of the City Code to establish no parking zones on Bradington Drive, east side, from roundabout to Gans Road; Bristol Lake Drive, both sides, from Bristol Lake Parkway to roundabout; Bristol Lake Parkway, east side, from north end to Gans Road; and Gans Road, both sides, from 1,200 feet West of Bradington Drive to 1,700 feet east of Bristol Lake Parkway.

Discussion

For the past few years, Public Works staff has assisted the Parks and Recreation Department by installing temporary no parking signs along streets near the Gans Creek Recreation Area. This has occurred for special events that draw a large crowd or have a large number of participants (such as SPLAT! or Cross Country events) that take place at the Gans Creek Recreation Area. The temporary No Parking signs have been placed in locations that will cause issues if vehicles are parked on these streets due to the streets being narrow and unimproved; cars parked along these streets would make it very difficult for emergency service personnel to respond to any emergency incidents that may occur in this area.

Staff would like to pursue the permanent establishment of no parking zones on Bradington Drive, east side, from roundabout to Gans Road; Bristol Lake Drive, both sides, from Bristol Lake Parkway to roundabout; Bristol Lake Parkway, east side, from north end to Gans Road; and Gans Road, both sides, from 1,200 feet West of Bradington Drive to 1,700 feet east of Bristol Lake Parkway. As more events occur at the Gans Creek Recreation Area, the establishment of the permanent no parking zones will no longer require Public Works staff to install temporary no parking signs for each large event that occurs.
