Executive Summary

This is an Ordinance to approve the adoption of the FY 2021 Annual Budget.

Discussion

The FY 2021 Annual Budget being proposed by the City Manager has been submitted to the City Council as required by City Charter. Staff has prepared a separate Resolution setting the public hearings for the FY 2021 Annual Budget to be held on August 17, September 8, and September 21. This procedure will allow several opportunities for public input on the many items covered by the budget process.

In addition to the public hearings, the City Council will be holding a budget work session to further discuss, in general detail, departmental revenues and expenses proposed for the coming fiscal year. The City Council budget work session will be Thursday August 13th, 2020.

Following the work session and the public hearings, any final adjustments will be made by Council prior to the passage of the budget on September 21, 2020.
