Re: Hazardous Moving Violation (HMV) Enforcement Unit Grant FY2021

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing acceptance of the Full Time Hazardous Moving Violation (HMV) Unit Grant in the amount of \$147,363.20 from the Missouri Department of Transportation and authorizing the City Manager to sign the contract.

## Discussion

This is a new grant that will fund one (1) full time HMV officer at 100% of officer's salary/benefits and provides additional funding for an additional vehicle and equipment. This grant position will concentrate on hazardous moving violations in high traffic crash areas. Types of violations include: speeding, driving too fast for conditions and/or following too closely.

This contract period is October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The Full Time HMV Unit Grant will offset 100% of the cost budgeted for one new officer position in FY21 (\$85,363.20) and pays 100% of new vehicle and equipment up to \$62,000. Both the personnel and the vehicle/equipment portion of this grant have been included in the FY21 budget documents.

Long-Term Impact: No anticipated cost for years beyond two.
