Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the ELC CARES contract between the City of Columbia and Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$71,150 for the period of August 1, 2020 through March 31, 2022.

Discussion

This agreement provides ELC CARES funding from Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services assist with local efforts surrounding case investigation, contact tracing, coordination and reporting activities related to COVID-19.

The CARES Act funding from the Boone County Commission has to be spent by December 30, 2020. The ELC CARES contract extends until March 31, 2022. Public Health & Human Services will utilize these funds no earlier than December 31, 2020 which will enable the department to continue with four temporary, full-time disease investigators for 12.5 weeks into 2021.
