Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Increasing Adult Influenza Vaccination Rates program services contract between the City of Columbia and Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$20,000 for the period of September 1, 2020 through February 28, 2021.

Discussion

This agreement provides funding from Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to provide reimbursement of administrative fees associated with immunizing through mass vaccination clinics and time spent conducting outreach.
