Executive Summary

United Healthcare (UHC) is providing the City a \$40,000 wellness allowance to use for eligible wellness programs in 2021.

Discussion

This is the ninth year UHC has granted a wellness allowance to the City of the Columbia. The wellness credit may be used by the City for eligible wellness programs for City employees. Eligible services are outlined on the attached list. The City's HR-Employee Wellness staff will coordinate the programming.

Fiscal Impact
