## ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Cosmo Park: Sports Field Lighting Controls Project: Park staff is proposing to use contract labor to upgrade the existing lighting controls for two locations in Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area (Cosmo Park). Staff is proposing to upgrade the existing manual controls for the Musco sports field lighting systems on the black and gold baseball/softball fields at Antimi Sports Complex and on soccer fields #4 and #5. Contract labor will be used to replace the manual controls at these two locations with the Musco Control-Link System. The upgraded controls eliminate manual on/off capabilities at each location and the lights are programmed by park staff via smart phone or computer for each day of use. This allows staff to control the usage of the lighting systems with access from any location. The upgraded system also eliminates unauthorized use of the sports field lights and eliminates the issue of lights being left on overnight at each location. Eliminating these two issues will lower utility costs associated with the operation of the lighting systems. The Musco Control-Link System has already been installed at multiple locations in the park system, including Atkins Sports Complex, American Legion baseball fields, and the other four baseball/softball fields at Antimi Sports Complex. The project is identified in the City's FY-2021 CIP and funded by annual park improvement funds from the 2015 Park Sales Tax. Park staff anticipates completion of the work by late spring 2021.
