SHOW ME COURTS AGREEMENT

This document constitutes an Agreement between City of Columbia, Missouri (the City) and the Office of State Courts Administrator (OSCA), collectively referred to herein as the "Parties," for the implementation of the Show-Me Courts (SMC) court automation software. The agreement shall govern the long term use of the court automation software.

Background: Show-Me Courts is being developed for use as the case management system for the courts in Missouri and when all the current functionality is available in SMC, will replace the Justice Information System (JIS). Updates and new functionality to SMC will be deployed on a regular basis to the courts.

The office of State Courts Administrator, in coordination with the Missouri Court Automation Committee, agrees to provide:

- 1. A suite of applications that meet the statutory and Supreme Court rules requirements.
- 2. Support.
- 3. Court Staff Training.
- 4. Communications with the court.
- 5. Back-up of data.

The Municipality agrees to:

- 1. Establish and maintain in effect a local ordinance to assess and collect the Court Automation Fee as required by Section 476.056, RSMo.
- 2. Provide and install necessary equipment for the implementation of SMC that meets Missouri Court Automation Infrastructure Standards. The Missouri Court Automation Infrastructure Standards may be found at: http://www.courts.mo.gov/page.jsp?id=61273.
