Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Boone County Agreement for Purchase of Services to continue to develop the Boone County Food Policy Council, effective January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2022 in the amount of \$20,100.00.

Discussion

Public Health and Human Services is receiving support from the Boone County Community Health Fund to develop the newly-formed Boone County Food Policy Council by creating Food Policy Plan and educational resources. The plan will identify and promote food policy priorities based on best-practice and community data and increase access to healthy food.
