Re: Proposed Private Common Collector Elimination Project #28 Hickory Hill Drive and Sunset Drive

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration a resolution authorizing staff to proceed with a preliminary design to determine the feasibility and costs associated with the elimination of private common collector sewers along Hickory Hill Drive and Sunset Drive.

## Discussion

Based upon the Sewer Utility's current information of the sanitary sewer system in the area, there are seven (7) parcels along Hickory Hill Drive and Sunset Drive that are connected to two (2) separate private common collector sewers and eligible for upgrade to public gravity sewers. The petitions requesting public sewer that the City received were signed by property owners from six (6) of the seven (7) parcels. The private common collector sewers that serve the area are in poor structural condition and need to be replaced. The attached diagram shows the potential project area where the shaded parcels submitted a petition. Copies of the petitions are attached. If directed by Council, staff will proceed with a preliminary design to determine the feasibility and costs associated with the project and move forward with the Standard Public Improvement Process. Eliminating private common collector sewers is one of the goals for the 5-year Action Plan in the Columbia Wastewater and Stormwater Integrated Management Plan.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$35,000 has been appropriated to the project for preliminary design.

Long-Term Impact: The preliminary estimate for the project is \$250,000, which includes design, easements, and construction. In accordance with Section 22-253 of City code, financing for this project will be through Sewer Utility – Private Common Collector Elimination funds.
