Executive Summary

Staff is requesting council authorize the City Manager to execute a right of use permit with The Curators of the University of Missouri, to install and maintain a directional sign within a portion of the South Old Highway 63 right-of-way (see attached exhibits A and B).

Discussion

The University of Missouri is requesting approval of a right of use permit to install and maintain a directional sign within a portion of the South Old Highway 63 right-of-way. The proposed directional sign would be constructed at a location within the South Old Highway 63 right-of-way (see exhibit A), to direct deliveries to their facility located at 1601 South Old Highway 63 (see exhibit B).

The right of use permit agreement outlines the responsibilities of the University of Missouri. The work will not begin until the proper construction permits are obtained, and the work scheduled with the division of Building and Site Development. Further the University of Missouri will not obstruct or block any City street or sidewalk during construction without first obtaining permission from the City.
