Re: An Ordinance Amending Chapter 6 (Buildings and Building Regulations) to Expand the

Delay of Demolition Permits from 30 Days to 45 Days

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for City Council consideration an ordinance amending Chapter 6 (Buildings and Building Regulations) to expand the delay of demolition period from thirty (30) days to forty-five (45) days from the date of application for a demolition permit. The delay is intended to give the City of Columbia Historic Preservation Commission adequate time to review and discuss demolitions of structures that are fifty years and older.

Discussion

At the February 1, 2021 City Council meeting, the Council received a report from staff on behalf of the Historic Preservation Commission requesting that the current delay of demolitions be expanded from thirty days to forty-five days following the submission of an application. Council directed staff to prepare an ordinance making the change.

The City of Columbia Building Code (Chapter 6, Article II, Section 6-17 Amendments, subsection 3308.8) contains provisions for Historic Preservation Commission review of demolition permits when the structures to be razed are fifty years or older. The review is advisory, and allows for outcomes such as voluntary salvage of useful fixtures, documentation of the building to be razed, and general awareness of the loss of buildings in the community. In rare instances the delay might attract resources to save a historic building.

The proposed ordinance expands the demolition review permit from thirty to forty-five days. No other changes have been made. Provisions to waive the forty-five day delay for life-safety reasons remain in the code. The delay does not apply to structures less than fifty years old.
