Traffic tends to travel over the speed limit on William Street, as well as on the intersecting Windsor Street, which is also the city's Bike Boulevard.

The intersection of William and Windsor is only a two-way stop, with a crosswalk across William, the nonstop-signed street

There are three schools in the immediate area (Windsor St Montessori, Stephens Lab School, and Benton Elementary) with a significant amount of children foot traffic going on field trips to Lions Stephens Park and Stephens Lake Park, also in the immediate area. Windsor has an increasing number of cyclists crossing William as well.

Comments:

The data demonstrate a significant and alarming upper rate of travel by users of both North William St., between Paris Road and East Walnut St., and Hinkson Avenue, between Paris Road and Old Highway 63. Hinkson Avenue, in particular, has been used numerous times in recent years for high-speed chases involving CPD and those running from CPD; I have personally witnessed cars going airborne at the intersection of Hinkson Ave. and North William St. In addition, the high rate of travel on Hinkson coupled with one-sided parking, has resulted in numerous accidents in which parked cars were damaged or totaled over multiple instances. We have had three telephone poles knocked over by reckless drivers, one car flipped onto a cement berm that is approximately 20 inches tall, and a car that drove into a tree that subsequently fell onto and punctured the roof of another car. I cannot count the number of times that accidents have occurred at the intersection of Hinkson and North William, and obedience to the 4-way stop at Hinkson and North William is optional. I am honestly very surprised no serious injury has occurred here yet.

I support speed humps, speed tables, bulb outs, chicanes. Anything, really, except for stop signs. Stop signs do not work. I challenge anyone who says they do work to come and record the number of vehicles that fail to stop at Hinkson and North William; I would not be surprised if they found between 10 and 30 vehicles per day.
