AN ORDINANCE

authorizing and ratifying a cooperative service agreement with The Curators of the University of Missouri, on behalf of University of Missouri Health Care, for COVID-19 vaccination provider services; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is a highly infectious and dangerous disease that on March 11, 2020 was declared by the World Health Organization to be a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 epidemic, there have been declarations of emergency enacted by the President of the United States, the Governor of the State of Missouri and the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, there is a necessity for certain vaccination services be available to individuals in response to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, University of Missouri Health Care employs health care providers who are trained in vaccine administration and is willing to make such providers available to the City of Columbia.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and ratifies a cooperative service agreement with The Curators of the University of Missouri, on behalf of University of Missouri Health Care, for COVID-19 vaccination provider services. The form and content of the agreement shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
