I understand the limited options, but the current locations are awful and inconsiderate of the small bushinesses and people who live and work in the area. The unsightly trash, overloaded dumpster next to Orr St. Studios is constantly abused with construction waste and when students are moving out it's surrounded with mattresses and furniture. The smell is horrible too. When it freezes, the alleyway in front of that dumpster is extremely slick from the liquid sludge draining off of the dumpster. Many older people work in Orr St. Studios and have/had many visitors throughout the weekday and events and walk very near the dumpster. I am opposed to the Compactor Relocation at Wabash Bus Station. My business has been in the Balsamo Warehouse since 2008 and I have the Adopt-A-Spot on the corner of Ash (Bicycle Boulevard) and Orr Street. I have many concerns about the proposed relocation: Safety, parking for clients and staff, depreciation of area, wasteful use of City resources, blind spots for cyclists and pedestrians, fire administration building and transparency with businesses directly impacted by this relocation.

Safety is my first concern. Businesses in the Warehouse are open until 10pm and serve multigenerational clientele. There are issues with the homeless population already and the decreased visibility with people walking to their vehicles, picking up kids from class and bicyclists trying to navigate and already busy area. We already have very limited parking for the eight very high traffic businesses in our building. Removing anymore parking would be detrimental for the employees and the patrons of each business. The area was designated an adopt a spot about 8 years ago and I have spent time and money making the space beautiful for the neighborhood. I adopted the area because it used to have huge bushes that collected trash/debris and was a safety issue, now there is visibility all around for pedestrians and cyclists. I am very concerned that the city did not contact the business owners that are directly impacted with this proposed change. I am also perplexed about the way this project came up again. We have a perfectly functioning trash compactor, which I use daily, that does not need to be relocated. I do think that the

dumpster behind Orr Street Studios should be removed. We have been in this space for 13 years and now you want to bully us by putting a trash compactor in our front yard. I just do not think this is fiscally responsible for the City of Columbia waste management. And it has come to my attention that the committee that proposed this original plan to the City had an influential property owner with businesses attached to the existing alley. This appears to be very manipulative. The current trash compactor could use a new fence and landscaping. Also, the current location is easily accessible for the waste department. I am also a member of NVAD and do not agree the move is a positive impact on the area. Please just leave the trash compactor where is it and remove the dumpster behind Orr street and save the City of Columbia people \$75,000. Finally, last time this proposal came up, we were able to get 2000 signatures from clients and neighbors that were opposed to the relocation and removal of parking and the safety issues. I am very thankful that you are listening to my concerns and I am thrilled that you have removed the recycling from this relocation project. I still believe this is fiscally irresponsible. I appreciate your attention to this matter.

I am wanting to express my opinion of the concerns businesses in the Ark District has shared with me regarding repositioning the Refuse compactor to the corner of the bus station. I am a client of the Beach Salon and looking at that corner has been such a beautiful thing to see when I visit. The Beach has kept that spot beautiful for the city and for the area for a number of years. This area has a number of local owned business and they need our city's support. Downtown is being destroyed with high rise apartments and tearing up landscaping.
