

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of traffic calming devices on Maplewood Drive between West Broadway and Stanford Drive; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, virtual interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of traffic calming devices on Maplewood Drive between West Broadway and Stanford Drive were held by the Public Works Department from November 30, 2020 through December 11, 2020 and May 3, 2021 through May 14, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on July 6, 2021. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of traffic calming devices on Maplewood Drive between West Broadway and Stanford Drive necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include the construction of seven (7) speed humps at the following locations along Maplewood Drive:

- Near 100 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 204 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 308 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 401 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 509 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 902 Maplewood Drive.
- Near 1000 Maplewood Drive.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$30,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from Annual Traffic Calming Funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
