Re: Second Amendment to an Interconnection Agreement with Truman Solar, LLC

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration of an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute a second amendment to an interconnection agreement with Truman Solar, LLC.

## Discussion

Truman Solar, LLC has recently contacted staff and requested that the current First Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement for the solar project be modified to amend the address of the seller, amend some interconnection customer information, and amend the project milestone dates to reflect the actual dates of construction.

Truman Solar, LLC has completed work on the solar project and began delivering energy to the electric utility on May 7, 2021.
