Re: Authorizing construction of a Recycling Drop Off Center at the Parks Management Center located at 1501 West Business Loop 70.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing construction and the call for bids through the Purchasing Division of a Recycling Drop Off Center at the Parks Management Center located at 1501 West Business Loop 70. The estimated cost for the project is \$30,000.00 and will be paid from Solid Waste Utility funds.

Discussion

The Solid Waste Utility plans to construct a recycling drop off center in an existing under-utilized parking lot at the Parks and Recreation Department's Park Management Center located at 1501 West Business Loop 70. The proposed project includes constructing a perimeter enclosure that will consist of a concrete block wall topped with a chain link fence and placing receptacles for containers and fiber material. It is anticipated that this proposed facility will be similar to the drop off sites on State Farm Parkway and on the South Providence outer road.

The public hearing for this improvement was held on May 3, 2021. Staff is now prepared to begin the construction of the project utilizing City forces and existing term and supply contracts previously bid through the Purchasing Division. The estimated cost for the improvements is \$30,000 and will be paid using Solid Waste Utility funds appropriated to project RF0071. RF0071 has been budgeted for additional drop-off recycling facilities in the south and west part of the city.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The estimated cost of the project is \$30,000 and will be paid for with Solid Waste Utility enterprise revenue funds.

Long-Term Impact: There are no long term fiscal impacts anticipated due to installation of these improvements.
