


Valleyview - Old





Roads and Parking

\$1,500,000

 \$150,000 per year for maintenance and improvements to the roads and parking lots in the park system.

Major Maintenance

\$1,500,000

• \$150,000 per year for projects that become a priority and/or exceed operating budgets.

ADA Compliance

\$250,000

• \$25,000 per year to complete improvements to meet ADA compliance in parks, facilities and trails.

City/School Projects

\$200,000

• \$20,000 per year for improvements to the school system playgrounds and recreation facilities.
