#### **Executive Summary**

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting a waiver from the requirements of section 16-258 to allow amplified family-friendly music for the Columbia Chamber of Commerce's "Small Business Fest" at Clary-Shy Community Park.

#### Discussion

The Columbia Chamber of Commerce has requested the use of Clary-Shy Community Park on Thursday, October 7, 2021 from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

The Columbia Chamber of Commerce has requested a waiver from the requirements of section 16-258 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music from 3:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 7, 2021.

The City Event Committee has approved the application for this event pending Council approval. A Parks Special Use Permit will be issued upon Council approval.

Per City Ordinance 24-73b, an operations agreement is only required for a downtown street closure if the event is to take place the day before, or the day of, any scheduled University of Missouri home football game. The aforementioned requested events are not on University of Missouri home football game weekends.
