Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a purchase of social services agreement with Columbia Interfaith Resource Center, for the purchase of 24-hour emergency shelter services, and an associated business associate agreement.

Discussion

At its May 3, 2021 meeting, Council approved B 164-21 amending the FY 2021 annual budget by appropriating funds for public assistance programs, as recommended by staff in the report REP28-21 Potential Uses of Reserve Funds presented at the April 19, 2021 Council meeting. The appropriation included \$75,000 in order to expand emergency shelter capacity in response to the ongoing pandemic, for the winter of 2021-2022.

Staff issued a RFP for these services in July, 2021. One proposal was received in response. Based on the review and rating of the proposal, staff and the Human Services Commission are recommending the City establish a purchase of social services agreement with Columbia Interfaith Resource Center for 24-hour emergency shelter services for homeless persons in isolation/quarantine. The agreement is for an amount not to exceed \$75,000 for the period of December 1, 2021 through March 1, 2022. This agreement also necessitates establishing a business associate agreement with the provider.
