Re: Agreement with Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for Overdose Data to Action Program

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Program Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for Overdose Data to Action Program, in the amount of \$41,500.00 for the period of September 1, 2021 through August 31, 2022.

Discussion

This contract's purpose is to achieve CDC desired outcomes of decreasing rates of opioid misuse and opioid use disorder, increasing provision of evidence-based treatment for opioid use disorder, decreasing rates of Emergency Department visits due to misuse or opioid use disorder, and decreasing drug overdose death rates, including prescription and illicit opioid overdose death rates.
