BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 and Section 3 of Resolution No. 136-20 are amended as follows:

SECTION 2. The Growth Impact Study Working Group shall consist of <u>five</u> (5) seven (7) members who demonstrate a diverse interest and/or background in one or more of the following areas:

- Local government finance;
- Planning, design, or construction of public infrastructure;
- Demography;
- Statistics and data analysis;
- Housing;
- Real estate;
- Environmental management; and
- Social equity and social justice

SECTION 3. The Working Group shall hold meetings, attain a quorum, and enforce attendance requirements as set forth in this section.

- (a) The Working Group shall meet at such times and places accessible to the public to be determined by the chair of the Working Group. Special meetings may be called by the chair of the Working Group. All meetings shall comply with the requirements of the Missouri Sunshine Law and the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia and, except as otherwise provided by law, shall be open to involvement and participation by as many additional community members who desire to attend.
- (b) Three (3) Four (4) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
