I. PRE-FORUM MEETING WITH TASK FORCE MEMBERS AT 4:30PM

Task Force ran through the evenings events including a discussion on engaging members of the public and recommendations on gathering community feedback.

II. COMMUNITY FORUM BEGINS AT 5:30PM

The forum began with a 45 minute presentation from Mayor Treece, Eric Hempel (Sustainability staff), Jay Hasheider (Task Force Chair) and Shockey Consulting. Topics included: a welcome to the public and the reasons why Climate Action in Columbia is important, a brief overview on the community survey results, the planning process and progress to date, and a run down of "dot-voting" and the activity would work. Members of the Task Force also breifly touched on each sector in the plan and why community feedback is important.

After the presentation, community members were encouraged to stop in to a breakout room containing specific information about each sector: Transportation, Housing/Buildings, Waste, Energy, Health and Natural Resources. Each room contained a large poster listing the Task Force's priority actions as well as the other actions being considered for the plan. To determine community support, each person was given five sticker dots to vote on which actions they would invest thier tax dollars in. Community members were also given the opportunity to fill out additional comment cards and speak with City staff and Task Force members about their thoughts.
