

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Central Bank has requested assistance from the City to share the cost of repairing sidewalk along the north side of Walnut Street between Providence Road and Second Street. The sidewalk improvements will include removing and reconstructing existing sidewalk panels that are cracked and deteriorated. The sidewalk renovation agreement with Central Bank will allow the bank to repair the sidewalk utilizing the City's existing term and supply contract. The City will reimburse the bank up to a not to exceed amount of \$9,471.02 for the construction. Construction is planned for spring of 2023.

Funding source: 1/4 cent CIP Sales Tax
