2021 and FY 2022 funds

Executive Summary

Attached for Council consideration is a resolution approving agreements with Job Point. This agreement is reallocating a combined total of \$102,000 in FY 2021 and FY 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

Discussion

On September 18, 2023 the City Council approved the reallocation of FY 2021 and FY 2022 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. There was an opportunity for public comment at this meeting. Agreements were approved on November 20, 2023 for the Foodbank of Central & Northeast Missouri (\$199, 269) and Woodhaven Learning Center (\$140,000).

Attached is the agreement for Job Point for the replacement of floor coverings, ceiling tiles, window replacement, fire doors, exterior gutters/down spouts and general facility improvements at their facility at 400 Wilkes Boulevard. This reallocates \$88,425.70 from FY 2021 CDBG funds and \$13,574.30 of FY 2022 CDBG funds. The total reallocated amount is \$102,000 of CDBG funds.
