Re: Authorizing the Temporary Restriction of Driving Lanes and Closure of Sidewalk by ACME Constructors, contractor for the University of Missouri, to remove and replace a turbine

generator at the Power Plant along South Fifth Street.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing ACME Constructors, contractor for the University of Missouri, to temporarily restrict driving lanes and close the west sidewalk of South Fifth Street to remove and replace a turbine generator at the MU Power Plant between East Stewart Road and Elm Street from October 03, 2023 through December 29, 2023.

Discussion

The traffic impacts of South Fifth Street between East Stewart Road and Elm Street from October 03, 2023 through December 29, 2023 include:

- Both driving lanes will be shifted to the east.
- Closure of a portion of the west sidewalk.

Staff authorized a 30-day restriction for the driving lanes and closure for the sidewalk beginning September 19, 2023. ACME Constructors, contractor for the University of Missouri, will be removing and replacing a turbine generator at the MU Power Plant. Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plans and has no other issues with their request.

The University of Missouri owns all of the property adjacent to the closure.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
