AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code associated with parking provisions on portions of Locust Street and Waugh Street; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Columbia, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-324. Parking prohibited.

When signs are placed, erected or installed in each block, giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the streets or places hereinafter set forth:

...

Locust Street, both sides, from Providence Road to Fourth Street.

Locust Street, north side, from Waugh Street to College Avenue, except for staff of Locust Street Expressive Arts Elementary School.

...

Watson Place, east side, entire length.

Waugh Street, east side, from Locust Street to a point three hundred fifty (350) feet south.

...

Sec. 14-334. Parking time limited in designated places.

When signs are placed, erected or installed in each block or designated city parking lot giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for longer than the period of time hereinafter set forth. Changing of the position of a vehicle from one (1) point directly to another within the same block or parking lot shall be deemed one (1) continuous parking period.

- (6) *Twenty minute parking limit:* Between 7:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. when Columbia public schools are in session:

Locust Street, south side, from Waugh Street to sixty (60) feet west of the west curblane of College Avenue.

~~Waugh Street, east side, from Locust Street to three hundred fifty (350) feet south of the south curblane of Locust Street, except that vehicles displaying hang tags 1 through 10 issued by Locust Street Expressive Arts School are allowed to park for twenty-four (24) hours.~~

...

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
