Re: Authorizing the Temporary Closure of Driving Lanes, Parking Lanes, and Sidewalk along Hitt Street between University Avenue and Rollins Street.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing SIRCAL Contracting Inc., contractor for the University of Missouri, to temporarily close driving lanes, parking lanes, and sidewalk along Hitt Street between University Avenue and Rollins Street from May 16, 2022 through August 22, 2022, to construct chilled water distribution pipe, control conduit, and domestic water utilities.

Discussion

The driving lane, parking lane, and sidewalk restrictions/closures include:

- Closure of both driving lanes, parking lanes, and sidewalk of Hitt Street from May 16, 2022 through June 22, 2022.
- Restrictions of both driving lanes, Closure of both parking lanes of Hitt Street, and Closure of the sidewalk on the east side of the street from June 23, 2022 through August 22, 2022.

SIRCAL Contracting Inc., contractor for the University of Missouri, will be constructing chilled water distribution pipe, control conduit, and domestic water utilities serving the Campus of the University of Missouri. Staff has reviewed the attached traffic control plans and has no other issues with their request.

The University of Missouri owns all of the property adjacent to the closure.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
