Executive Summary

A report on homelessness for Council review and situational awareness.

Discussion

The City of Columbia has identified homelessness as a priority. This report highlights the City's million-dollar investment in homelessness-related efforts during the past year. It summarizes intervention milestones, including how the Opportunity Campus may reshape the local response landscape. Finally, it recommends that the City pursue a five-year strategic plan to better align resources and proactively plan for the future.

The report also gives background information on pallet shelter villages. While Columbia has not pursued building these villages, these villages have been discussed by city staff and Council several times over the past few years.
