A RESOLUTION

amending Resolution No. 32-16 which established the Mayor's Task Force on the U.S.S. Columbia to add the City's fire chief as an ex-officio member.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Resolution No. 32-16 is amended as follows:

SECTION 2. The Mayor's Task Force on the U.S.S. Columbia shall be composed of nine (9) members who shall have an interest in advocating for the continued positive relationship between the City of Columbia and the U.S.S. Columbia. Members shall be appointed by the Mayor. After the initial appointment of members and upon a vacancy, the Task Force shall send a recommendation to the Mayor for any new appointment. In addition to the nine (9) members, the City fire chief shall serve as one (1) nonvoting ex-officio member, the President of Columbia College shall appoint one (1) nonvoting ex-officio member, and, the Commanding Officer of the Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps (NROTC) program on the University of Missouri-Columbia campus shall appoint one (1) nonvoting ex-officio member. A quorum to hold a meeting shall consist of five (5) voting members. All meetings shall be open to involvement and participation by as many additional interested community members who desire to attend.
