Re: Authorizing a Special Event Operations Agreement with Radar Hospitality Company for an outdoor concert on August 20, 2022.

Executive Summary

This resolution authorizes the operations agreement for an outdoor concert on August 20, 2022 in downtown Columbia.

Discussion

Dan Radar, owner of Radar Hospitality Company, has requested closure of Sixth Street from Cherry Street to Locust Street and Locust Street from Sixth Street to Seventh Street. The closure is requested from 3:00 p.m. until 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, August 20, 2022.

The City Special Events Committee has worked closely with Radar Hospitality Company to address all aspects of the application and operations agreement and to develop plans including but not limited to: event layout, public safety plan, insurance, solid waste plan, and an accessibility plan.

Because of the size and scope of this event and because it requires a street closure, as well as city services and equipment, an agreement must be executed between the city manager and event organizer, and approved by the City Council, per Section 24-73(b) of the City Code.

The City Special Event Committee and the Organizer will continue to work together prior to the start of the event to ensure all plans are approved by the appropriate City staff and departments to ensure a safe and successful event for all involved.
