An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the agreement between the City of Columbia and Columbia School District No. 93 for Teen Outreach Program in schools and community, for the period ending June 30, 2023.

This agreement's purpose is to formalize the roles and responsibilities of the City of Columbia/Public Health and Human Services and the Columbia Public Schools for the implementation of the Teen Outreach Program in Columbia Public Schools. The Teen Outreach Program is a grant funded, positive youth development program that Public Health and Human Services implements in partnership with Columbia Public Schools to decrease course failure rate, school dropout, and teenage pregnancy.
