Re: Columbia Police Foundation Donation to Columbia Police Department

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared a resolution to accept a donation of one (1) police canine from the Columbia Police Foundation.

Discussion

The Columbia Police Foundation is a non-profit organization that supports the men and women of the Columbia Police Department by providing equipment, training, and other support via private fundraising efforts. The Columbia Police Department retired two (2) of their Police canines in January 2025 due to the age of the canines. The Foundation would like to donate one (1) police canine to the Department to replace one of the recently retired canines. This canine will not be trained to detect marijuana to ensure compliance with legislative changes regarding legalization of marijuana in Missouri.
