Re: Authorizing a bid call for construction of the Garth Avenue improvement project.

Executive Summary

Authorizing a bid call through the Purchasing division for the construction of the Garth Avenue (Texas Ave to Thurman St) improvement project. The initial interested parties meeting for this project was held on August 8, 2023 and a second interested parties meeting was held on February 26, 2025. The public hearing was held on April 8, 2025.

Discussion

The Garth Ave improvements is a major maintenance street and sidewalk project to be completed between Texas Ave and Thurman St. This project will include reconstruction of failing pavement panels, curbs, and sidewalk sections in various locations along Garth Ave. The project will also include the construction of new sidewalk on the east side of Garth Ave, filling in the two sidewalk gaps between Texas Ave and Thurman St. Finally, the project will include an asphalt overlay along Garth Ave between Texas Ave and Thurman St. Construction of the improvements are anticipated to be underway by the summer of 2026.

The initial interested parties meeting for this project was held on August 8, 2023 and a second interested parties meeting was held on February 26, 2025. The public hearing was held on April 8, 2025. Acquisition of one permanent street easement and 20 temporary construction easements will be necessary for construction of the project.

The total project cost estimate for design, easement acquisition, and construction is \$1,627,700. The project will be funded with the ¼-cent capital improvement program sales tax and the county road tax funds.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The total project cost estimate is \$1,627,700 and will be funded with the ¼-cent capital improvement program sales tax and the county road tax.
