**AN ORDINANCE**

authorizing a memorandum of understanding with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for the CoMo yards and small grant program to assist homeowners and businesses create native Missouri landscapes to support and improve urban biodiversity; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a memorandum of understanding with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for the CoMo yards and small grant program to assist homeowners and businesses create native Missouri landscapes to support and improve urban biodiversity. The form and content of the memorandum of understanding shall be substantially as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
