Re: Authorizing the acquisition of easements for construction of the Sunset Lane PCCE #29 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the acquisition of easements necessary for the construction of the Sunset Lane PCCE #29 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project, as shown on the attached diagram. A public hearing was held on November 7, 2022.

## Discussion

The Sunset Lane PCCE #29 Sanitary Sewer Improvement Project will consist of installing approximately 624 feet of sewer main and four (4) sanitary sewer structures. The proposed project will also include new private service connections and replacement of service laterals, only as necessary, to reconnect the existing laterals to the new sewer main. The proposed sanitary sewer project will eliminate a private common collector (PCC) sewer in the area that serves fourteen (14) properties along West Broadway, West Boulevard South and Sunset Lane. Current policy requires that the temporary construction easements and permanent sewer easements necessary for the construction of the project be donated by the property owners of the parcels currently being served by the PCC sewers. However, in addition to the donated easements, this project will require the acquisition of one (1) temporary access easement, three (3) temporary construction easements (TCE) and two (2) permanent sanitary sewer easements (PSSE) from two (2) property owners not benefiting from the project. See attached diagram and description of the proposed easement to be acquired.

Construction plans are 75% complete with construction expected to begin in mid-late 2023.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The resolution estimate is \$595,000 from the Sewer Utility enterprise revenue funds.

Long-Term Impact: Minimal operating costs.
