Re: Ordinance Authorizing a Tourism Development Sponsorship Agreement with The Curators of the University of Missouri for the 2025 Missouri State Senior Games and Show-Me State Summer Games

Executive Summary

This ordinance would authorize an agreement for the use of \$20,000 in Tourism Development Funds to support the 2025 Missouri Senior Games and Show-Me State Summer Games (MSG), a Signature Series event under the Tourism Development Program.

Discussion

The Show-Me State Games, founded in 1984, is a non-profit initiative of the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Health and is hosted annually by the University of Missouri. Focused on promoting health, wellness, and community engagement, the Games provide a wide range of competitive and recreational sports opportunities for individuals age 50 and older.

The MSG is now recognized as the largest state games in the nation, welcoming approximately 15,000 participants across more than 40 sports. This large-scale event draws thousands of athletes and their families to Columbia, resulting in significant tourism activity including overnight stays, restaurant visits, and retail spending. The event has a measurable and positive economic impact on the local economy and serves as a cornerstone of Columbia's summer tourism calendar.

The requested Tourism Development Funds will be allocated toward essential event expenses including site fees, medals, advertising, and officials. The Convention & Visitors Bureau Advisory Board has reviewed the funding application and unanimously recommends approval of \$20,000 in Tourism Development Funds to support the continued success and impact of the 2025 Show-Me State Games.
