Re: Heart of Missouri CASA

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between Heart of Missouri CASA and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On July 10, 2024, the City Manager signed an agreement with CASA for professional and advocacy services. At CASA's request, this amendment modifies Exhibit A by decreasing the number of "advocacy" service units by 4,442 and increasing the "professional services" units by 2,234. The adjustment reflects CASA's accelerated use of professional services, but does not change the amount not to exceed. All other terms of the agreement remain unchanged.
