Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Public Health Emergency Response

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Public Health Emergency Preparedness contract. The agreement period is July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

Discussion

This agreement allows the Columbia / Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to receive funding from the State of Missouri for public health emergency preparedness. The purpose of this contract is to demonstrate measurable and sustainable progress toward achieving public health and healthcare preparedness capabilities and to promote prepared and resilient communities. The agreement provides \$170,689 in funding which is used for staff time. This agreement has been in place since 2002. The funding awarded varies slightly from year to year. This is due to fluctuations in the funding the State receives, along with changes in the US Census data. This agreement is \$360 less than the previous Amendment.
