Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Maternal Child Health Services

Contract Amendment 05 Impacted Ward: Citywide

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Maternal Child Health (MCH) Services Contract Amendment 05 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$175,264.81 for the period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026. This contract now includes funding for two separate PHHS services: MCH Services (\$70,797.81) and home visiting (\$104,467.00).

Discussion

Maternal Child Health (MCH) funding enables the department to provide community based maternal-child health planning, outreach and education to citizens of Boone County. Addressing adolescent mental health is the current focus for the MCH Services activities. The MCH Services portion of this contract is a total of \$70,797.81, with the majority of the funding (\$63,989.48) allotted for personnel. This is a decrease from last year's MCH contract total (\$73,124.36). This year's amendment incorporates home visiting services, which has been a separate agreement in years past. The program utilizes the Health Families America evidence-based community home visitation model to serve at-risk pregnant women and families with young children. The home visiting portion of this contract is a total of \$104,467.00, all allotted for staff time. This is a decrease from the previous year's home visiting contract (\$147,503.64). The home visiting contract has transitioned from an agreement with the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) to the Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS).

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This is grant funding. Prior year amounts were used to calculate the FY26 budget revenue. The decrease in offsetting revenue, totaling \$45,363.19, may impact the general fund.
