Re: Fostering Life-Change Opportunities

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between Fostering Life-Change Opportunities (Flourish) and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On December 5, 2023, the City Manager signed an agreement with Flourish for clinical case management and job coaching services. This amendment changes Exhibit A to remove "amount not to exceed" and "number of units of service", and adds a new service of Case Management with a new service rate (\$10.02) and number of units (4,219). All other terms remain unchanged.
