Re: First Due Contract Amendment Pulsara Integration

Impacted Ward: Citywide

Executive Summary

Fire is seeking approval for a contract amendment to the existing Locality Media, LLC dba First Due contract to add an integration between First Due and Pulsara.

Discussion

Pulsara is a secure, HIPAA-Compliant communication and logistics platform designed to unite healthcare teams during patient care. It replaces disparate communication methods like radio, phone calls, and faxes, with a single digital channel, connecting paramedics, nurses, and doctors to reduce treatment times and improve efficiency for emergencies and routine care.

Fire Department responders are using Pulsara to document patient information including assessments, treatments, and medications, which is then shared with responding paramedics, and ultimately doctors and nurses at the hospital. This shared platform increases efficiency and reduces errors in documentation of patient handoffs.

This integration between First Due and Pulsara, brings in the patient information documented on scene to the department's Record Management System (RMS) also increasing the efficiency and accuracy of the department's patient reports.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$1,600 first year cost, covered by existing funds from Fire.

Long-Term Impact: \$300 yearly ongoing cost subject to price increases allowed within the First Due contract.
