Re: Appropriating Funds for Additional FY 2022 Election Cost

Executive Summary

Additional funding is needed for election cost associated with the payment of the November 2021 elections.

Discussion

Initial budget estimations for the November and April elections are much lower than the actual cost. Finance, along with the Parks department, is proposing to transfer the cost of the November election from the Parks fund to the General Fund.

Historically, all elections are budgeted in the City Clerk's budget to keep election related expenses in one place for historical data purposes. Elections that take place for departments outside of the General Fund are paid for by the respective fund through a transfer.

The City Clerk's budget is currently \$118,660, which should be enough to cover the April election. The Parks portion of the November election is \$147,500. We will need to transfer the funds from Parks to the General fund, then increase the City Clerk's budget for the by \$147,500 to cover the November election expense.
