Re: Columbia Supreme

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement for services between Columbia Supreme and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. This agreement with Columbia Supreme addresses one of the priority areas, community violence. Under this agreement, Columbia Supreme will provide evidence-based youth mentorship and sports-based positive youth development for youth ages K-12. Mentorship is provided through afterschool programming and a summer intensive program. Mentorship for older youth includes career awareness and financial literacy. Sports-based positive youth development is a combination of a sport, for example basketball, track, football, and mentorship. Columbia Supreme aims to double the number of youth currently served by the organization. The agreement is for \$150,000 and will end on January 31, 2027.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This would issue \$150,000 for a project which is funded with City ARPA funds.
