Re: Authorizing a Bid Call for Construction of the Scott-Broadway Sidewalk Project

## Executive Summary

Authorize a bid call through the Purchasing Division for the construction of the Scott-Broadway, Christian Fellowship Rd. to Silvey St., sidewalk project. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held on August 8, 2022 and a public hearing was held on December 19, 2022.

## Discussion

The Scott-Broadway sidewalk project will include:

- Removal of the existing asphalt shoulder from the west side of Scott Boulevard and the north side of West Broadway between Christian Fellowship Road and Route ZZ
- Construction of a 6-foot wide sidewalk and the replacement of sections of the curb between Christian Fellowship Road and Route ZZ
- Construction of a 6-foot wide sidewalk and 2.5-foot wide curb and gutter to fill in the sidewalk gap along the north side of West Broadway between Route ZZ and Silvey Street
- Construction of a pedestrian crosswalk across Route ZZ
- Construction of new ADA ramps and landings at the intersections of Christian Fellowship Road and Scott Boulevard, Mount Carmel Lane and Scott Boulevard, Scott Boulevard and Wales, Route ZZ and West Broadway and on the west side of the Silvey Street and West Broadway intersection.

Five temporary construction easements and one permanent sidewalk easement from five property owners will be necessary for construction of the project. The estimated total project cost is \$696,600 and includes design, easement acquisition, utility relocation, and construction. MoDOT will fund 64% of the project cost with the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funds and the City will fund the remaining 36% with the ¼-cent Capital Improvement Program (CIP) sales tax funds. Construction is planned for spring of 2024.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The City's 36% match is estimated at \$250,776 and will be funded with the ¼-cent Capital Improvement Program (CIP) sales tax funds.

Long-Term Impact: Per ordinance, sidewalks are maintained by the adjacent property owner.
