Re: Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Missouri

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Missouri and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On December 5, 2023, the City Manager signed an agreement with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Missouri for site-based mentorship services. This amendment includes a timeline created by the agency and reviewed by city staff. All other terms remain unchanged.
