Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Show Me Healthy Women Contract

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Show Me Healthy Women (SMHW) Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in an amount not to exceed \$4,000 for the period of June 30, 2025 through June 29, 2026.

Discussion

This contract allows Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to provide breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services' (MDHSS) SMHW program eligible clients. The contract also allows PHHS to provide cardiovascular screening, diagnostic testing, and lifestyle education to clients enrolled in the Department's Well-Integrated Screening and Evaluation for Women Across the Nation (WISEWOMAN) program. There is no change to the award amount from the previous contract.
