Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between Burrell, Inc and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On September 16, 2024 the City entered into an agreement with Burrell, Inc to address one of the priority areas, mental health. Under the agreement, Burrell, Inc will construct a nonprofit crisis center on its property at 90 E Leslie and 107 E Texas. Once the construction of the crisis center is complete, Burrell, Inc will provide behavioral crisis services for Columbia residents. This amendment includes a timeline created by the Burrell, Inc and reviewed by city staff. All other terms remain unchanged.
